The items are paperboard packaging or tableware without ink or varnish.

For this type of item there is only used materials which is suited for the intended use of the items.

Specification of the product

The items are manufactured using the following materials:

Paperboard: Alaska® Strong

Intended Use

Based on documentation from our suppliers the items may safely be used for food packaging and may stand in direct contact with dry and fatty foodstuffs, in addition the paperboard may stand in direct contact with moist foodstuffs with its uncoated reverse side.

The packaging is intended for use under the following conditions of temperature and time:

- Freezer/fridge
- Room temperature (up to 40°C for more than 24 hrs)
- Temperatures up to 90°C

The packaging is **not** intended for use under the following conditions and temperatures:

- De-freezing or re-heating of food in microwave oven
- Conventional oven

Additionally, they may also be used as secondary packaging.

Compliance with European food contact legislations

With reference to the documentation, from our suppliers of the used raw materials and providing the items are used as intended, we hereby declare that the items comply with the following regulations:

- **Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 October 2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food
- **Commission Regulation (EC) No 2023/2006** of 22 December 2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food

Compliance with National food contact legislations

With reference to the documentation, from our suppliers of the used raw materials and providing the items are used as intended, we hereby declare that the items comply with the following regulations:

- **Danish Regulation BEK nr. 681** of 25/05/2020 on Food Contact Materials and on Penal Provisions for Violation of Related EU Acts
- **U.S. FDA - Code of Federal Regulations Title 21 Chapter 1** – Section 176.170 “Components of paper and paperboard in contact with aqueous and fatty foods” and Section 176.180 “Components of paper and paperboard in contact with dry food”
- **BfR Recommendation XXXVI**. Paper and board for food contact

Substances

Intentionally added shall mean deliberately utilized in the formulation of a material or component where its continued presence is desired in the final product to provide a specific characteristics, appearance, or quality. Please note that we do not analyze the paperboard for the substances listed below. Information below is based on information given by our suppliers.

Bisphenol A (BPA)

We hereby declare that Bisphenol A are not intentionally added in the manufacturing of the raw materials, nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.

MOSH/MOAH

We hereby declare that Mineral Oils Saturated Hydrocarbons and Aromatic Hydrocarbons are not intentionally added in the manufacturing of the raw materials, nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.

We are aware that both MOSH and MOAH can be present in virgin fibers used to produce paperboard.

PFOS/PFOA

We hereby declare that Perfluorooctanesulfonic acid (PFOS) and Perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA) are not intentionally added in the manufacturing of the raw materials, nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.

Phthalates

We hereby declare that phthalates are not intentionally added in the production of the paperboard nor in the production at Schur Pack Denmark a/s.

Allergens

The paperboard is manufactured using wheat or barley starches, which contain small amounts of gluten. However, the gluten content in the paperboard does not exceed 20 mg/kg, and may therefore be considered ‘gluten-free’ according to **Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 828/2014** of 30 July 2014

Compliance with additional legislation and regulations

Based on the documentation from our suppliers we hereby declare that the items comply with the following legislations:

- **Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 December 2006 concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)
- **European Parliament and Council Directive 94/62/EC** of 20 December on packaging and packaging waste

Disposal

In compliance with the European Packaging and Packaging Waste directive, the items can be disposed in accordance with:

- **DS/EN 13430 Packaging** – Requirements for packaging recoverable by material recycling
- **DS/EN 13431 Packaging** – Requirements for packaging recoverable in the form of energy recovery, including specification of minimum inferior calorific value
